Pre-Camp Check List

- Automated camper reports are emailed to outpost commanders or the person they designate. To change to who receives the report contact Doris at 715-258-8118 or doris@wnmdag.org
- Camp registration and camp fees are collected online. Inform parents of additional food and transportation charges for your outpost.
- Hang camp posters & distribute flyers that refer parents to sign up online.
- List camp in church bulletin, start praying
- Monitor weekly registration reports (sent daily closer to the start of camp) and collect your outpost charges.
- Ensure that a pastor reference form is completed for all adults 18+.
- Pack supplies to decorate campsite in Super Hero style

When You Arrive

Check-In

- Bring a check to cover:
 - Any outstanding balances.
 - Scholarships your church has arranged.
- Turn in pastor reference forms for each adult 18+.
- Pick up camper T-shirts and patches.
- Post the schedule at your campsite.
- Outposts are encouraged to decorate campsite in Super Hero style.

Event Helpers

All leaders are expected to help with camp events. We ask that each outpost commit to meet at the altar before every evening service for prayer.

Meal guest sign-up

Take the opportunity to thank the summer camp staff by inviting them to a meal at your outpost.

A sign-up sheet will be posted at the registration table in the training center. Please sign up when registering.

Service Patrol

Rangers interested in being on the Service Patrol must be entering 6th grade or older and memorize the Bible verse by Friday at noon as well as participate in pre service prayer. Sign-up will be available at the Training Center.

Security Patrol

Two adult leaders are needed each night (Thurs – Sat) from 11:00 pm to 12:30 am for night patrol. Please sign up when checking in.

Vehicles in camp

Vehicles may only enter through the main entrance and exit through the east gate by the dumpster.

All vehicles are to be out of camp by noon Friday.

Vehicles will not be allowed in the campground until after the Sunday service is over.

No one under 18 may drive vehicles on camp property.

Parking of vehicles is allowed on Spencer Lake Road, but your vehicles must be parked in a diagonal manner at least three feet from the road to avoid being ticketed.

Carry Out / Burn Your Trash

We have limited garbage space this year so please pack paper products to burn or plan to carry out your trash.

Who can attend?

Boys & Leaders

All boys grades 3-12 (don't have to be a Ranger) and their RR leaders. All camping equipment and food is to be provided by the outpost.

A background check and pastoral reference is required for all adult leaders 18+.

Visitors

Visitors are allowed between 7:30am and 10:30pm.

Visitors do NOT have to pre-register, but must check in/out at the camp office and wear the official camp visitor name tag on camp grounds.

Visitors allowed to spectate, but may not participate in any of the activities.

Camp Fees

\$75 per person*

Early Bird Discount

Registrations completed before June 6 will receive a \$15 Early Bird Discount at checkout, bring the cost to \$60 per person.

Full Price

Registrations received on June 6 to June 21 will be charged the full \$75 per person.
